If this paint fails to perform as specified above, Wattyl will provide, free of charge, sufficient paint to recoat the affected areas. Paint failures caused by any breakdown of a previous coating, by incorrect use the product, or by causes outside Wattyl's control are not covered by this warranty. Labour and equipment costs are not covered by this warranty.
